- Install and set up Enterprise Security Manager.

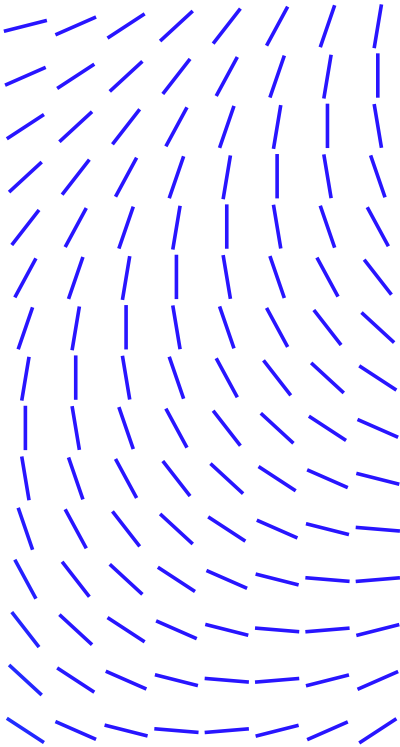
