
Running the reports:

VSE: DAT Deployment

- Within the ePO interface, click the Menu button at the top left corner, navigate to Reporting and select Queries & Reports.

OR


- If you access Queries & Reports frequently, click on Queries & Reports in your ePO Navigation bar.




- Use the Quick Find search box, enter **VSE** or **DAT Deployment** and click Apply (ensure you have selected your 'All' Group first)



- Navigate down to the **VSE: DAT Deployment** query



- Click Run in your Actions column
 - This report will provide a pie chart to highlight the 3 highest DAT versions and one slice for all other versions




- On the top right side of the page, click **Options | Export Data**.

ENSTP: AMCore Deployment


- Return to Queries & Reports

 - If Query found, follow the same steps for **VSE: DAT Deployment** to run and export results into PDF format

Importing AMCore Deployment query


- Navigate to LCS ePO report instructions page provided in your email and open the DAT Deployment Report zip file
 - Locate the **AMCore Deployment** query XML
 - Save this query to a location on your system




- In your ePO console, navigate back to Queries & Reports
- Click the Import Queries option at the top of the page



- Click Browse to locate the **AMCore Deployment Query** in your saved location, select and click Open




