





- Click [OK](#) within the wizard to complete the import process.

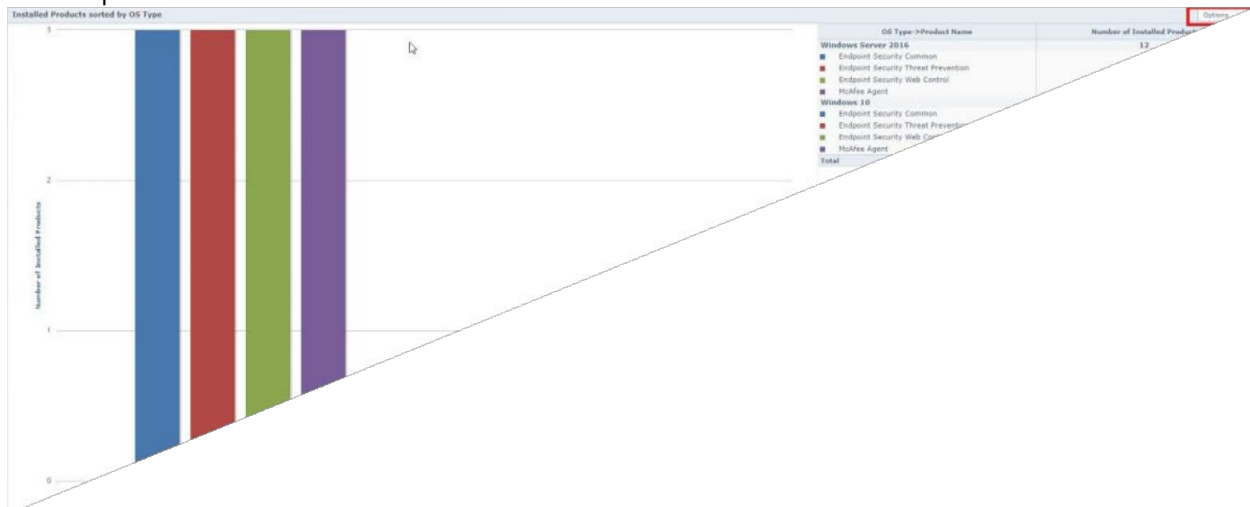
## Importing the Product Summary Query

- Download the provided file called [Installed Products sorted by OS Type.xml](#) and save it to the Desktop or a folder.
- Click the [Queries & Reports](#) button in the ePO favorites bar along the top.
- Click [Import Queries](#) button at the top of your screen and browse to the location where you placed the file.
- Double click [Installed Products sorted by OS Type.xml](#), and double click the file.
- You can place the Query in either a new group you create, or an existing group.
- Click [Save](#) at the bottom right of the screen.

## Viewing and Exporting the Protection Summary Report

- The import process should return you to the Queries & Reports area. If not, simply click the [Queries & Reports](#) button in the ePO favorites bar along the top.
- Based on where you stored the imported XML file, expand the Groups on the left, and locate the container with the new query as shown below.
